Automobiles and motorcycles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Official/factory name and type of vehicle • Manufacturing number (VIN number) • Vintage (year when the vehicle was manufactured) • Type of fuel • Weight of car • Invoice or other confirmation of car purchase (original & legible copy) – will be returned on shipment delivery date • Registration book of the car (original copy) – will be returned on shipment delivery date • Copy of driver's licence • Another original completed form for exemption of customs duty • Calculation of the costs for the transport – must have 3 parts: 1) outside the EU; 2) within EU outside Czech Republic; 3) within the Czech Republic 		<p>Duty free, subject to re-exportation.</p> <p>During temporary importation period the car must not be sold.</p> <p>The car must not be older than 8 years of age from the date of manufacture and also must not be younger than 12 months of age.</p>
