Household goods	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Original passport with visa.</li> <li>• Valid resident or working permit.</li> <li>• Detailed inventory in Portuguese dated, valued in USD and signed by the shipper.</li> <li>• Packing list.</li> <li>• Original bill of lading (no express release accepted) / AWB.</li> <li>• Letter from the employer explaining that the client is starting a new contract.</li> <li>• Invoices for the electrical and Hi-Fi appliances and for all the items bought less than 6 months before the shipment's arrival.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• HHG's are allowed into Mozambique Duty free if they have been in the owner's possession for at least 6 months (otherwise they are taxed by the customs).</li> <li>• Used home computers and electronic items are accepted as personal effects.</li> <li>• For diplomatic shipments, all customs documents must be received more than 15 days before the shipment's arrival to obtain the document for free entry.</li> <li>• Personal effects must arrive maximum 6 months after the shipper.</li> <li>• All foreigners must pay a tax to the customs of 1% of the inventory value.</li> </ul>	
Prohibited articles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Firearms, ammunitions.</li> <li>• Unlawful drugs.</li> <li>• Alcohol and other spirits are prohibited and should be sent separately.</li> </ul>		
Motor vehicles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Original registration card.</li> <li>• Original passport.</li> <li>• Original Bill of Lading.</li> <li>• Original invoice of the car.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mozambican citizens can import 1 vehicle (belonging to them for at least 6 months) if they have spent more than 1 year abroad for professional purpose.</li> <li>• Foreigners can import 1 vehicle if it belongs to them for at least 1 year at the date of arrival. Taxes will be from 5% to 115% declared value depending on the size.</li> </ul>
